Historic Information: Samuel C. Norton purchased Lots 16 & 17 in August of 1880, and a month later, he took out a mortgage with the Stillwater Building Association which it appears he used to build the house at 819 S. Second Street. No sooner was it built then he sold it to Thomas Shattuck, a Stillwater policeman, who lived there for a number of years. When Shattuck bought the property and house, it was valued by the tax assessor at \$1100.
