**Historic Information:** Thomas Sutherland, a Canadian-born contractor and builder, along with his wife, Susan, purchased this property in the fall of 1881, and built a house at 1006 South Third Street soon afterward. Sutherland lived for a time behind this house at 1009 South Fourth Street. He also lived at other addresses in this immediate neighborhood. In 1894, Sutherland moved to Hutchinson, Minnesota. The house was purchased by Frederick Swenson who hired a local contractor, Baird & Johnson, to raise the roof of the house and add a second story on for a cost of \$200.
