Physical Description: This building has a two-glass/two-paneled Italianate front door (the glass in the door is broken) and a dentilled frieze on its flat-roofed portico. The portico has a newer concrete deck, but otherwise appears original. The facade is asymmetrical. An addition in the rear is two stories on the east because the lot slopes to the east. There are some aluminum storm windows on the west. The rear has an addition with an intersecting gable. There is a shed-roof addition at the very rear. The original house was probably two rooms. It has a deteriorated two-bay side-gabled garage sheathed in weatherboard. Its appearance is consistent with a construction date in the 1860s.

Significance: This house is ___ is not X preliminarily eligible to the National Register of Historic Places. This study is a preliminary determination because it is the first of the Stillwater neighborhoods to be surveyed.
